



Adobe Photoshop CC Introduction

Overview: This course focuses on some of the basic features of Adobe Photoshop. Students will learn how to navigate the environment and use Photoshop tools to work with photographic images and become oriented with Adobe Bridge. Although Photoshop is used by a variety of professionals, from photographers to designers to videographers, Photoshop Introduction will focus mainly on the photography component. The illustration and animation techniques are covered in subsequent levels of Photoshop.

Prerequisites: Students should have a basic comfort level with digital photography and basic computer skills.
